













List of rewards

	<p><u>Silver</u> As per green, with evidence of 'good citizen' behaviours and exceptional achievement in learning</p>	
	<p><u>Green</u> Maintained green zone behaviour expectations Consistent positive choices Engaged in learning Respectful to all</p>	
	<p><u>Amber</u> Disrespect that required a warning Not focussed or engaged with learning, required a warning</p>	
	<p><u>Red</u> Disrespect to peers, adults, learning or school property despite warning and opportunity to change choices</p>
